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Trade / Vocational school: Educational institution designed to train students for a specific job in a skilled trade career.

Apprenticeship: A training program that combines classroom studies with hands-on experience to become skilled in a specific trade or profession.

Associate degree: A two-year degree that prepares students for a specific career or further education.

Bachelor's degree: Degree awarded to students who complete a 4-year college program.

Master's, Doctorate or Professional degree: Educational awards typically requiring more than 4 years of college level study.

FAFSA: Free Application for Federal Student Aid

Financial aid / student aid: Grants, scholarships, work study and loans that help pay for college expenses.

Grant: Money to attend college that the student does not have to pay back.

Student loan: Money that is borrowed and used to attend college that the student must pay back to the lender.

Tuition: The cost to attend college for an established period of time (typically based per semester/year)

Income: The amount of money received during a period of time in exchange for labor or services.

Hourly pay: Employees are paid a specific rate (of money) per hour of work.

Salary pay: Employees are paid a specific amount of money per year of work.
